Cold Weather Shelter Voucher Program: Vouchers for temporary hotel/motel stays during winter months are available for families with children, the disabled and the elderly. Housing for Veterans:

Veterans Housing Choice Voucher Program (VASH): All homeless Vets qualify for this program which puts them at the top of the Section 8 list immediately. The process can take up to six months.
